**HELP, HEALTH EQUIPMENT LOAN PROGRAM.....\$400.00**

**GOODY BAGS FOR LOW INCOME SENIORS**

This grant will help to pilot a new program which will provide goody bags for low-income seniors. These bags will contain hygiene products, household cleaning products, etc. The project will consist of quarterly handouts for the individuals in the HELP program.

**OUTDOOR COOKING EQUIPMENT**

The purchase of outdoor cooking equipment will allow the girls to cook in a controlled environment while learning valuable life skills. They will learn food preparation, nutrition, hands on practical cooking skills with limited equipment and supplies as well as science and math.

**CCYL NON-PROFIT FILING**

THE CCYL has been operating under the umbrella of the Grayson Area Chamber of Commerce; however, the purposes are different. The CCYL leadership feels it is now time to apply for 501 (c)(3) status, so that donations can be considered charitable contributions. This grant will be used to pay the filing fees.

**EQUIPMENT FOR THE LIVE FOR THE LIBRARY PROJECT**

This project will address the need for storytelling and social programs that are lacking during the current social distancing period. Online book readings, storytelling, and music will be provided to continue to engage with library patrons during social distancing restrictions.

**CARTER COUNTY ANIMAL SHELTER.....\$500**

**REDUCING STRAY CAT POPULATION**

This project will prevent unwanted feline litters reducing the stray cat population and improving the quality of life in Carter County. Feline owners of Carter County will be able to request a voucher from the Carter County Animal Shelter to cover a percentage of the total cost.

**LITTLE FREE LIBRARY**

Little Free Libraries book-sharing boxes improve book access and help tackle low literacy rates. By providing books all year, they can mitigate the "summer slide" where kids reading skills slip. The 24-hour availability makes it possible for kids and working parents to share books at times that are convenient. This project will purchase a Little Free Library at Olive Hill Elementary.
